

If you are planning on attending summer semester you may be eligible to receive financial aid. Follow the steps below to determine your eligibility.

- Complete the 2017-18 Free Application for Federal Student Aid ([FAFSA](#))

-- Lakeland will receive the results of your FAFSA in 3-4 business days. Check your Lakeland email to see if additional information is needed.

- Register for summer classes ([Class Schedule](#))

--Your award will not include summer aid until you register for summer classes.

--Your financial aid eligibility will be calculated using your enrollment as of the freeze date (end of the 100% refund period) of your earliest class. For example, if you plan to take one class first summer session, one class during the second summer session, and one class during the full summer session, you must register for all classes before the first summer session freeze date (May 24). Your aid will not be adjusted if you choose to add a class after your summer freeze date.

Summer term is part of the 2017-18 aid year. Any financial aid used in the summer 2017 could affect your spring 2018 eligibility. For instance, if you attend full time both summer 2017 and fall 2017 semesters, you will not have Pell Grant funds for the spring 2018 semester.

In order to be eligible for summer financial aid, you must be seeking a degree or eligible certificate from Lakeland Community College (LCC). You must have attended LCC during the 2016-17 academic year or plan on attending LCC fall 2017. If you are seeking a degree from another college, contact the Financial Aid Office at that college to inquire how summer funding can be used while attending LCC as a transient student.
